ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE ARGLO-FRILLIPPING OIL CORPORATION

KNOW ALL MUN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, all of whom are residents of the Philippines and citizens of the Philippines and of the United States of America, have this day voluntarily associated curselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the Philippines.

ED WE DO HENDY CERTIFY

I

That the neme of this corporation shall be ANGLO-PAILIPPINE OIL

formed is to embark in the discovery, exploration, development and exploitation of mineral oils, petroleum in its natural state, rock or carbon oils, natural gas, other volstils mineral substances and salt, or to mine, dig for or otherwise obtain from the earth the same substances as aforementioned and to manufacture, refine, prepare for market, buy, sell, and transport the same in crude or refined condition.

is formed is to embark in the discovery, exploration, development and exploitation of minerals in all other forms in the Thilippines and elsewhere and the business of mining in general in all of its phases and branches with all of its auxiliaries together with the businesses which are necessary and convenient to the efficient and economical prosecution of the above purposes.

That in the pursuance of such purposes, the corporation shall have the power:

1. To acquire gas and oil lands, leaseholds and other interests; to construct and maintain conduits and lines, tubing and piping for general purposes as well as for the use of the said corporation, to transport such oil and gas by means of such pipes, tank cars or otherwise, and to sell

and supply pipes, pipe lines and storage tanks to be used for the purposes of transporting and storing oil and gas, and to do a general pipe line and storage business;

- and to buy, sell, and deal in gas, oil and salt; to construct and maintain all railways, tramways; to acquire, construct, and maintain buildings, dwellings, stores, warchouses, machineries, plants, boats, roads and bridges, mills, works, and workshops, laboratories, power plants, derricks, drills, sawmills, and other effects whatsoever which the corporation may think proper to be acquired and constructed and/or operated for the pursuance of any of its purposes; to construct, maintain and operate telegraph and telephone lines convenient for the prosecution of its business; to obtain and prepare for market such other valuable minerals or materials as may be discovered in developing the land of the company.
- 3. Without particularly limiting any of the objects or purposes or powers of the corporation, the business or purposes of the corporation shall be from time to time to do sny one or more or all of the acts and things therein set, and all such other acts, things and businesses in any manner connected therewith, or necessary, incidental, convenient or suxiliary thereto, or calculated directly or indirectly to promote the interests of the corporation or emhance the value of or render profitable any of its properties or rights as such corporation may lawfully do; and in carrying on this business, or for the purpose of attaining or furthering any of its objects to do any and all acts and things and to exercise any and all other powers which a corporation or a juridical person could do and exercise which now or horeafter may be authorized by law, trustees, contractors, factors, lessors, lessees or otherwise either elone or in conjunction with other and in any part of the world and in addition to have and to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges now or hereafter belonging to or conferred upon corporations organized under the provisions of the law authorizing the formation of such corporations;

The searching and prospecting for ores and minerals and the location.

Leasing and registering and patenting of mineral claims of all sorts; the

purchasing, leasing or exchanging or otherwise acquiring or taking an option of mineral properties, claims, rights, concessions, licenses and grants; the securing from the government of the Philippines or from any other authority or individual, manicipal, or otherwise, of easements, timber or water rights, of privileges, licenses and concessions and the performance and the fulfillment of the conditions thereof, the carrying on of the business of metallurgists, contractors, assayers, manufacturers, importers, exporters, merchants, factors, agents, commission merchants and general workers; the carrying on, and engaging in the business of milling, concentrating, converting, smalting, treating, propering for market, manufacturing, buying and celling, exchanging and otherwise producing and dealing in ores, mineral and metals;

The purchasing and otherwise acquiring, the holding, operating, selling, and otherwise dealing in so far as the law permits of the units, stocks, securities, properties and assets, business goodwill, rights, franchises, contracts and the assuming of liabilities and obligations of any person or persons, firm, association or corporation, or organization;

The borrowing and lending of maney with or without security; the issuing of warrants, bonds, debentures and other negotiable and transferrable instruments, secured or unsecured for such amounts or in exchange for such properties as may be found advisable;

To have one or more offices outside of the Philippines and to conduct its business and exercise its powers in any part of the Philippines or in any other country;

The foregoing clauses shall be construed both as objects and powers of the corporation and it is hereby expressed that the foregoing enumeration of specific powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the general powers of the corporation.

That the place for the principal office of the corporation is to be established or located at the City of Manila, Philippines, with branches anywhere in the Philippines or abroad.
